Roadside Parking Ordinance

- The Town of Truckee has a **No Parking Ban**, effective November 1st thru April 30th annually. This prohibits parking in or on Town roads and rights-of-way. Violators can be towed or ticketed.
- Park behind snow poles. This will prevent you from being ticketed/towed and reduces the possibility of damage to your car.
- The purpose of this winter parking ban is to allow winter maintenance crews unobstructed snow removal and ice control routes.



Snow Berms

- Snow berms are the accumulation of snow cast aside by snow plows. Driveway approaches may become blocked (bermed) after snow plowing.
- The Town of Truckee does not remove driveway berms left by snow plows. Ask your property manager if you are responsible to clear the driveway and/or berm, or if there is a private snow removal contract in place.
- Do not deposit snow into public roads or rights-of-way.



Snow Plow Routes

- Plowing begins as soon as there is snowfall accumulation of 4" or more.
- Snow removal crews follow a prioritized plan for clearing streets of snow.
- Visit Truckee 511 for real-time snow plow and sand truck activities. Truckee 511 maps and tracks the movement of Town sand trucks and snow removal equipment on town-maintained roads, trails and sidewalks.
- Snow plow operators will return to widen roads as conditions warrant. Following a major storm, cleanup operations may continue for 3-4 days.



Trash/Recycling

- Set trash containers far enough away from the street (behind snow poles) to avoid damage by snowplows and blowers.
- This practice should be maintained during and after storms, when snow blowers widen the roadways.
