



SNOW REMOVAL

Winter Parking: 11/1/2025 - 4/30/2026

THE WINTER PARKING BAN prohibits parking on Town roads and public right-of-ways to ensure unobstructed snow removal, ice control operations and enhanced safety. Violators may face towing or ticketing. It is crucial to park fully out of the public right-of-way, as parking behind snow poles is not sufficient.


SAFETY TIPS

- During dangerous conditions such as whiteout storm events or icy roadways, avoid driving.
- If you must drive, exercise extreme caution. Driving on snow-packed and icy roads requires your full attention and demands your best driving skills.
- Have adequate snow tires or chains on your vehicle.
- Remember to brake slowly and leave adequate room between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you.
- Be patient, and drive at reduced speeds.
- Allow sufficient travel time to reach your destination.
- Drive defensively; be courteous.

Truckee is home to nearly 30 miles scenic paved trails that make getting from place to place via a bicycle a breeze. For user safety, there is a 15 mph limit on trails. Bike racks are numerous throughout town.

- TRUCKEE LOCAL ROUTE • FREE**
 Serves most major activity and shopping centers along Donner Pass Road and Brockway corridors.
- ROUTE HWY 267 • FREE**
 Travels between Crystal Bay and Truckee Railyard Mobility Hub with additional stops at Northstar Village and the Truckee Airport.
- ROUTE HWY 89 • FREE**
 Runs along the west shore of Lake Tahoe from Tahoe City to Truckee with additional stops in Olympic Valley.



THE SKI RACK SCOOP

Ski racks are available on most TART Connect vans. When ski racks are not available, riders can bring their skis into the vans/buses.

TRUCKEE DIAL-A-RIDE

Is available 7 days a week to all neighborhoods & commercial centers. Reservations are required at least 24 hours in advance of the requested ride. Dial-a-Ride is a door to door service provided to the general public and persons with disabilities. (Persons with disabilities that prevent them from using the Truckee Local Fixed Route System can contact the number below to receive priority service.)
